

Question

- Why do I receive the error The username and password pair you entered was not found when trying to sign in to a sourcing event I was invited to?
- Why can I not use my existing username and password to accept an event invitation?

Answer

- The invitation link you are clicking may have expired. If you have already connected your account to SSAB, please log in https://ssab.supplier.ariba.com.
- A functioning link that has never been used before will bring you to a screen that gives you the two options to either Sign Up for a new user account or Login with an existing one. Sign Up and Login are blue buttons and very noticeable.
- ► If you determine that the link needs to be replaced, please contact your SSAB buyer for a new invitation email.



4. The link in the e-mail does not work anymore

GOOD TO KNOW The link in the e-mails only works for accessing the event for the first time.

- SSAB <u>cannot</u> help with resetting passwords unfortunately.

If the link has expired, please contact the SSAB buyer who sent you this RFP and request that he/she resends you the RFP invitation email. The RFP link is typically valid for 30 days.

- 1. Access events In your address bar, enter "ssab.supplier.ariba.com".
- When entering the address "ssab.supplier.ariba.com", do not add "www" or "https".
- 3. Log in with your SSAB username and password.
- 4. Once logged in, click the table icon on the top and then Proposals tab.
- 5. Click on the SSAB customer tab.
 - This page has the RFP available for access.

5. I cannot see the event when I'm logged in

GOOD TO KNOW

There are a number of reasons you may not be seeing a sourcing event your company was invited to. Here we listed the most common reasons.

1. Did you receive an event invitation?


 Buyers invite suppliers to events by selecting each participant, so there is a chance that only one person from the company received an invitation. Only those who are invited to the event will have access.

2. Did you log in to the correct account?

 You might have more than one Ariba account.
 If you have multiple accounts, make sure you are logged into the account that was invited by SSAB.

> 3. Are you on the Ariba Sourcing platform?

 If you see Ariba Network, Ariba Discovery, or Ariba Contracts in the upper left corner, you are currently accessing another platform within your Ariba Commerce Cloud account and will not see the event here. (see next slide).






5a. I cannot see the event when I'm logged in

► You are not on the Sourcing login page

 If you see Business Network at the top of the login page and you log in, you won't see the RFP SSAB has sent to you, because you are in the wrong module.



If you would see Business Network,

- 1. Click on the arrow
- 2. Then change to **Ariba Proposals and Questionnaires**.

The **Business Network** SAP Ariba module is for companies that send POs to their suppliers via Ariba which SSAB does not do.

5b. I cannot see the RFP when logged in Some reasons

Did you log in to the correct Ariba account?

You might have more than one SAP Ariba account. If you have multiple accounts, make sure you are logged into the
account that was invited.

Do you have permissions to see the page?

To view your organization's Ariba Sourcing events, questionnaires, and Ariba Contract Management contracts, documents, and tasks, sub users need to have the permission Access Proposals and Contracts assigned. If you do not have the correct permissions, please contact your administrator. You can find the administrator's contact information by clicking your initials in the upper-right corner of the page and selecting Contact Administrator.

Is your user activated?

- It is possible that your user or organization profile is deactivated which will restrict your access to Ariba.
- If your organization profile on the buyer's site is Rejected you will not be able to register.


Are you directed to a blank page when you click on an event within your account?

- Security features on your computer might cause a blank page when accessing an event. Use the following steps to resolve this issue:
 - Check the URL on the blank or black page.
 - If the URL starts with HTTP, change this to HTTPS.
 - Navigate to the new page.
 - Accept any security warnings that appear in your browser.
- Ad Blockers can also cause this issue:
 - Check to see if an ad blocker is installed, such as AdBlock Plus and uBlock.
 - If one is installed, disable it and load the page again.
- If neither of these options help, try to log in using a different browser.



6. I see a questionnaire but not the RFP, why?

- ► If you see the below screen, it means you **must** <u>first</u> provide some information <u>before</u> you can access the RFP.
- This is not uncommon nor a mistake from SSAB.
 - SSAB might have created new questions since the time your company was registered.
 - Complete the Customer Requested Profile:
 - Complete all fields marked with an asterisk (*).
 - Click Submit.


1. How to get started


 Open the email you got from your SSAB buyer via Ariba with subject line "SSAB has invited you to participate in RFP"

2. Click the "Click Here" link in the e-mail to login to Ariba & access the RFP.


2. How to accept or decline an RFP invitation?

3. Review the RFP information published by the SSAB Buyer.







