


### 1. Log in to SAP Ariba




- Enter your username and password (that you created during the original registration phase).
  - Your username is <u>always written</u> in the RFP invitation email.
  - Your username is <u>case-sensitive</u>. Be careful!
  - Forgot your password?
    - Click on the "Forgot Password" link in the email or the link on the "login page".
    - Note: SSAB cannot reset username and password




# 2. To update your email address, phone number, username or password




- Go to the tab "Customer Requested"






- Prepare your updates






- Always indicate at least the date on which you did this update







- Submit your updated profile for approval to SSAB.

## How can you find out who is the administrator of your Ariba Network account?




The administrator then needs to login and navigate to the permission settings page to grant you the permission "Company Information" so you can edit/update ISO certificates or equivalent. (see next slide)



#### How can the administrator reach the permission settings page?


- ► The administrator needs

    - 3. Users






#### How to find the permission "Company Information"?

- Needed for non-admin users to be able to update ISO certificates




## The admin needs to create a role that will be assigned to your user and choose the needed permission(s)




## 4. Update your ISO certificates





- You will receive an automatic email from Ariba <u>once a year</u> asking you to update your profile.
- 30 days before the expiration date of your ISO or equivalent certifications, you will receive an automatic email from Ariba asking you to upload the new certificate.


